The dual challenge of the private sector in Mozambique



Demand of funding

- **Business model risk:** unclear path to profitability, unclear path to scalability, changes in BM
- **Country related risk:** foreign currency shortage, low customer ability to pay, regulatory regime uncertainty, political stability uncertainty
- **Knowledge and network:** lack of financing expertise, lack of contacts with financiers

Supply of funding

- **Type:** lack of matching finance for market needs esp. early stage growth capital, risk and development capital, patient equity
- **Size:** lack of smaller ticket sizes
- **Accessibility:** bloated preconditions, complex international standards of governance and reporting
- **Sequence:** equity investors prefer to follow others and refinance transactions rather than be “first” investors
- **Terms:** expensive terms

“Financing follows”: if there is less risk, more money will flow
